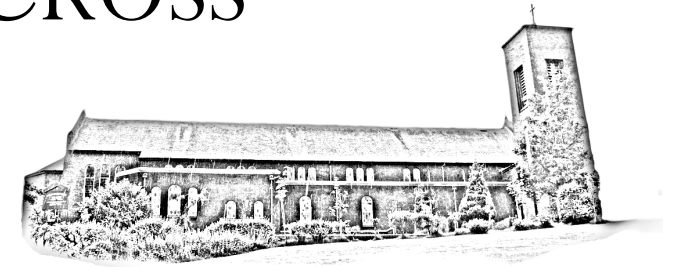

Mary's Meals work with some of the poorest and most vulnerable people in 12 countries across Eastern Europe, Latin America, the Caribbean and Africa. This collection of unwanted/unused clothing and bedding (all textiles) is turned into funds to carry out their work overseas. Last year the clothing collection generated the amazing sum of £112,000.

2 Black poly bags filled with good quality clothing could generate enough income to feed a child in Malawi FOR A YEAR approx £6.15. Currently they are feeding over 300,000 in Malawi alone.
