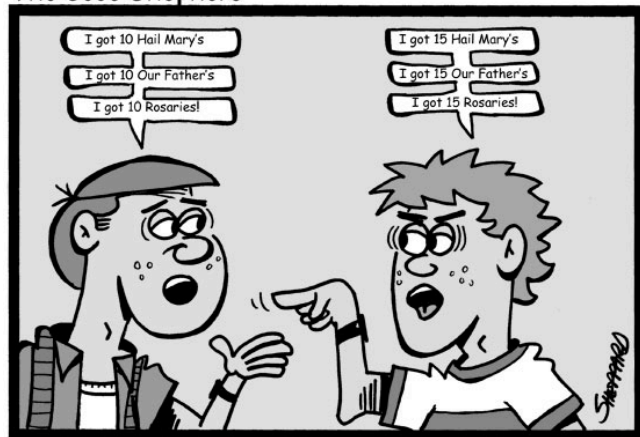

*Be King also of all who have disowned you: bring them back like the prodigal son to their Father's house, before they die of loneliness and hunger.*

*Rule the hearts of Christians separated from each other by reason of conscience or through failure of love: make them all one with you, our Shepherd & Teacher, in the sheepfold of your love.*

*Bless your Church with true freedom; grant to all nations, peace founded on justice.*

*Draw all hearts to yourself, so that the whole earth may join in one prayer: "Praise to the Heart of Jesus, our God and our Saviour: glory and honour be his for ever & ever."*
