

The law states: Anyone working - that is, either in a paid or voluntary capacity, with children, young people or adults at risk is obliged to complete a *PVG application* (*Protecting Vulnerable Groups*) – which now replaces the *Disclosure Forms*. The Diocese works with *Disclosure Scotland* to conduct these checks..."
