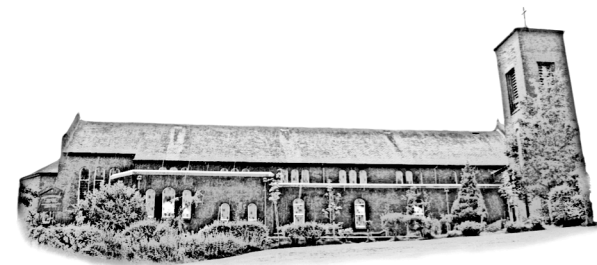

Postures at Mass The Archdiocese recommends “bowing our heads before receiving Communion” and then putting our hands or our tongue, out. *Holy Communion* may be received either on the tongue or in the hand (making as it were a “throne” for the Lord). The option of genuflecting before receiving Holy Communion is allowed.

When we receive from the Chalice we should do similarly and then take the Chalice in both hands.

Refugee Week (ends today- Sunday) “*I arrived in (Scotland) in the evening*” remembers *Munir*, a refugee from Syria who sought protection here just over a year ago. “*The sky was black, it was windy, I was on my own- my family were still in Syria. It felt terrible. But after a couple of weeks I started to meet people, to talk to them. They were such lovely, warm, welcoming people.*”
