Primary School Registration

For Holy Cross Primary. Children who reach the age of 5 years between 1st March 2015 and 29th February 2016 should be registered to start August 2015. Registration will take place: Monday 12th January at 1.30pm- 2.45pm; Tues 14th Jan. at 1.30- 2.45pm; Wed 14th Jan at 11am- 12noon; Thurs 15th January at 1.30- 2.45pm; and Fri 17th Jan at 11am- 12noon.

Parents are asked to bring their children's *Birth Certificates* and *must* bring "Proof of Address" in the form of the current *Council Tax Bill*. Where appropriate, the child's *Baptismal Certificate* may also be produced.

For St Andrew's Primary. Children who reach the age of 5 years between 1st March 2015 and 28th February 2016 should be registered to start August 2015. Registration will take place: Monday 12th January 9am- 12noon and 1pm - 3pm; Tuesday 13th Jan 1- 3pm; Wed 15th January 9am - 12noon; Thursday 17th January 9am - 12noon and 1- 3pm.

Please bring your child's *Birth Certificate* and as proof of residency, a *Council Tax Bill* or a copy of *missives/let agreement*. Please also bring a copy of a *Baptismal Certificate* if available. See Posters in Porch Area
