**Ash Wednesday** this Wednesday is a day of *fasting & abstinence*. Ashes will be distributed at 8.15am, 10am & 6.30pm Mass. The 8.15am Mass will then continue during Lent (Monday to Friday). The Readings will be read by Pupils from *Holy Cross Primary* engaged in the *Pope Francis Faith Award*. Please hand in *Palms* from last year to be burned for *Ashes* asap.



**Way of the Cross** A *Plenary Indulgence* is available to all who devoutly make the *Stations of the Cross*: here on Fridays and Saturdays after 10am Mass (barring a Funeral). The *Stations of the Cross* on Saturday will be led by Pupils from *St Andrew's Primary* who are engaged in the *Pope Francis Faith Award*. The Sick/ Housebound, prisoners can gain the same indulgence, if they spend at least one half an hour in pious reading & meditation on the *Passion & Death* of our Lord *Jesus Christ*. Normal conditions apply: be free from all attachment from sin; receive the Sacraments of *Penance* and the *Eucharist*; pray for the intentions of the Pope.
