Regarding the Parish Hall we cannot forget those who *staff* the functions and keep the place so *clean* (& so popular).

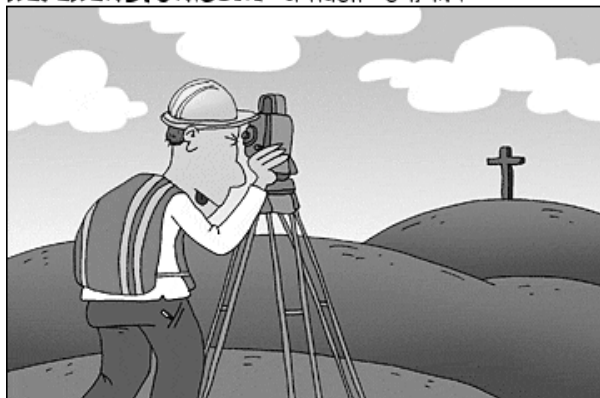
Divine Mercy Devotions next Sunday at 4.45pm (some leaflets in Narthex).
