Thanksgiving Mass by Holy Cross P4 & Classmates: Friday at 10am.

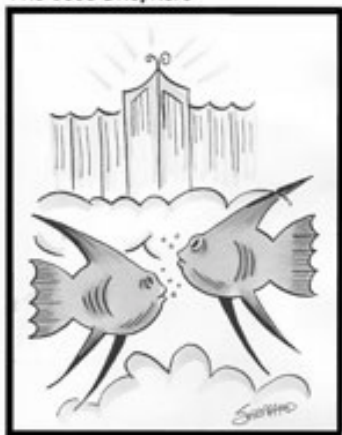

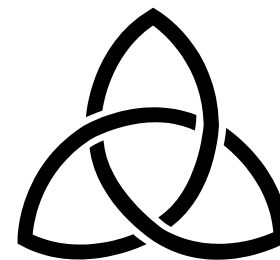

40 Hours Adoration begins next Sunday. Would "watchers" please put their names/ initials on the Sheet in the Porch area. On the Sunday (7th June) we will, of course have the Procession; on Monday (8th) and on Tuesday (9th) the *Holy Ghost Fathers* will lead us in a *Holy Hour* at 7pm.

Foodshare for *Cumbernauld Foodbank* you may leave non-perishable goods after any Mass next Sunday (*Corpus Christi*). Uplift around 12.40pm.
