Novena to the Sacred Heart Leaflets from *Pioneer Total Abstinence*, begins on Thursday: see porch area.

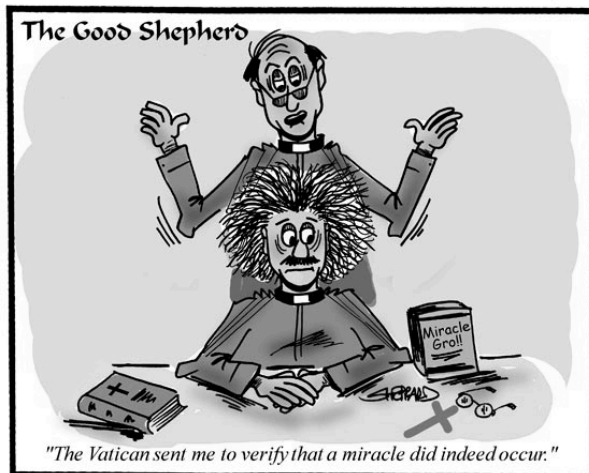

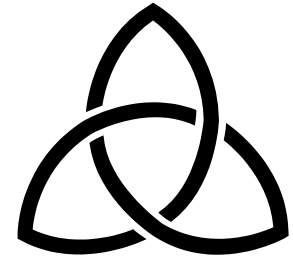

There will be an opportunity to meet *Bishop Keenan* in the Hall for a cup of tea/ juice etc. He is the youngest Bishop in Scotland. *Bishop John* hopes to visit both schools on Monday.

Kenyan Outreach Programme In thanksgiving for the support (financial, gifts of children's clothing or "old glasses") a short film will be shown at *Tuesday's Tea & Toast* on 24th May after 10am Mass. The film encourages nurses to volunteer, shows the work carried out by them & the contribution your gifts have made to the health of others in remote areas of Kenya.

Walk for Vocations to the *Schoenstatt Shrine* will be Sunday 19th June. Walkers will depart at 12.45pm to arrive at Campsie Glen for 5pm.
