Coffee Morning last Sunday raised £200. Proceeds will go to the Chaplain's Fund at *Our Lady's High*.

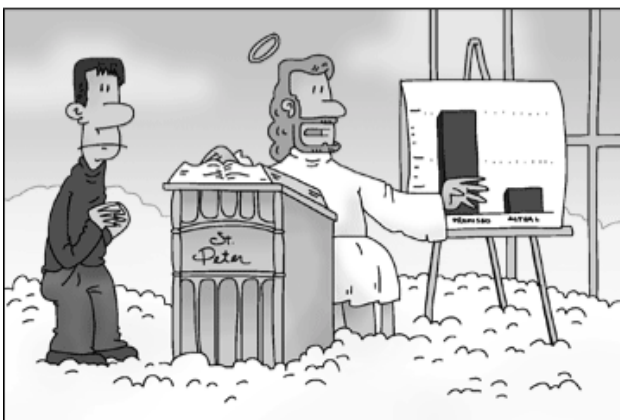
