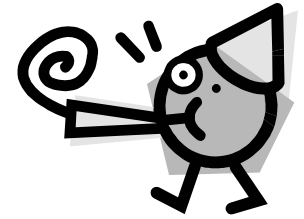


"I'd love to Mother but remember I am under 18."
