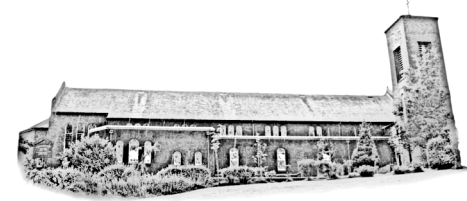

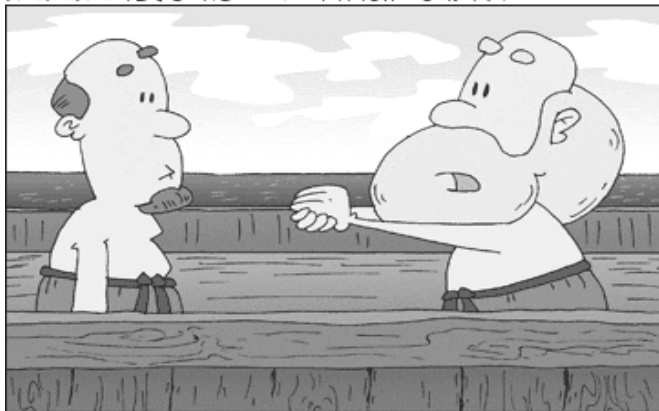
Novena to the Sacred Heart Leaflets from *Pioneer Total Abstinence*, begins on Thursday: see porch area.

Communion under both Kinds will be proffered next weekend- the Feast of the *Body & Blood of Christ*. "*Holy Communion* has a fuller form as a sign when it is distributed under both kinds. For in this form the sign of the *Eucharistic banquet* is more clearly evident & clear expression is given to the divine will by which the *new & eternal Covenant* is ratified in the *Blood of the Lord*, as also the relationship between the *Eucharistic banquet* & the *eschatological banquet* in the *Father's Kingdom*. Sacred pastors... should instruct the Christian faithful that the Catholic faith teaches that Christ, whole & entire, and the *true Sacrament*, is received even under only one species, & consequently that as far as the effects are concerned, those who receive under only one species are not deprived of any of the grace that is necessary for salvation.... At the same time, the faithful should be encouraged to seek to participate more eagerly in this sacred rite, by which the sign of the *Eucharistic banquet* is made more fully evident." [GIRM 281-282]
To receive from the Chalice, please bow, say "Amen", take the chalice in TWO hands, then hand back to the *Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion*. Children who have received their *First Holy Communion* may receive from the Chalice but in this parish it would happen when a Parent is obviously with the child & agreeing to this.
Incidentally, the wine used presently at Mass is *Fair Trade Wine*.
