Data Protection Big changes in law (*General Data Protection Regulation*) are taking place on 25th May. Every organisation requires strict permission from the living. For example, the parish will require the sick person's explicit consent in writing, to be put on the sick list overleaf. At present this law will apply from 12 years. The reasoning is found in the highly publicized abuse of personal data by some organisations. You may wish to contact your MEP regarding getting the correct the balance right. Word-of-mouth, from family members & sensible neighbours has been sufficient up until now for photographs etc. Sadly this represents another step in the *atomization* of society....

First Holy Communions will conclude this weekend. *Well done* both *Holy Cross Primary* and *St Andrew's Primary*!

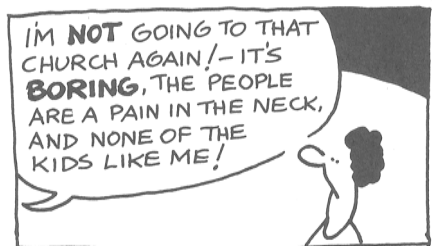
Finance Second Collection last week for *Communications Sunday*= £460 Next weekend the Second Collection continues for the remaining "pointing".
