**Annual Safeguarding Statement** will be made at Mass next week, and will incorporate the Statement from *Bishop Toal* on the publication of "*In God's Name*".

**(Re-) Blessing of Graves** for all those buried at *Kilsyth Cemetery* on June 24<sup>th</sup> at 3pm. In addition, the names of those who have died from June 2017 to end of May & who are buried there will be called out.

**Communion under both Kinds** will be proffered this weekend- the Feast of the *Body & Blood of Christ*. "*Holy Communion* has a fuller form as a sign when it is distributed under both kinds. Sacred pastors... should instruct the Christian faithful that the Catholic faith teaches that Christ, whole & entire, and the *true Sacrament*, is received even under only one species, & consequently that as far as the effects are concerned, those who receive under only one species

are not deprived of any of the grace that is necessary for salvation.... At the same time, the faithful should be encouraged to seek to participate more eagerly in this sacred rite, by which the sign of the *Eucharistic banquet* is made more fully evident." [GIRM 281-282] To receive from the Chalice, please bow, say "Amen", take the chalice in TWO hands, then hand back to the *Special Minister of Holy Communion*. Children who have celebrated their *First Holy Communion* may receive from the Chalice but in this parish it would happen when a Parent/ Carer is obviously with the child & agreeing to this. Incidentally the wine used at Mass today is *Fairtrade*. Finally could *Parents/ Carers, Teachers & Special Ministers* delicately ensure that the *Sacrament* is consumed before the person leaves the *Altar Rails*.
