Monday- Saturday at 10am At present, Pre-Registration is NOT required for *Weekday Masses*, just "turn up" & give the *Ministers of Welcome* your Contact Details... but NOT when there is a *Funeral*. Normally *Mass* is Streamed Live on *Parish Facebook Page*, via *Parish's Website* & *Parish YouTube*.

Baptisms see Fr Sullivan at the end of the *Mass* you attend; face-coverings worn & *Track & Trace*.

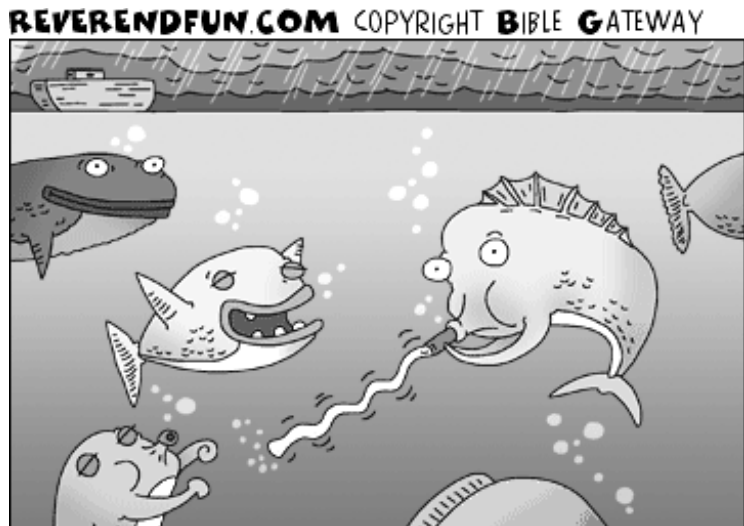
Used Stamps for the *Missions* see Container in Porch area.
