Receiving Holy Communion is normally by Practising Catholics. In addition, however, we cannot forget *Pope Francis'* helpful words: “*The Eucharist, although it is the fullness of sacramental life, is not a prize for the perfect but a powerful medicine and nourishment for the weak.*” *Evang Gaud 47.* Furthermore, the *Code of Canon Law* explains: Can. 844 §4. If the danger of death is present or if, in the judgment of the diocesan bishop or conference of bishops, some other grave necessity urges it, Catholic ministers administer these same sacraments licitly also to other *Christians not having full communion with the Catholic Church*, who cannot approach a minister of their own community and who seek such on their own accord, provided that they manifest Catholic faith in respect to these sacraments and are properly disposed.

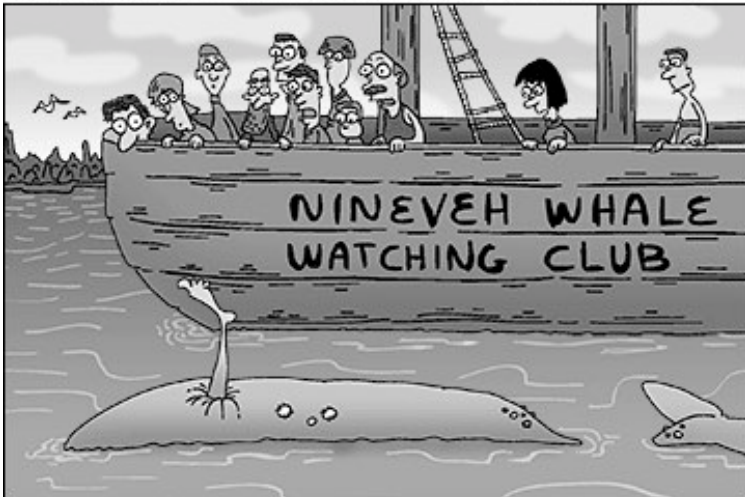
