Novena to Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal: After Mass on Tuesdays (barring a funeral).

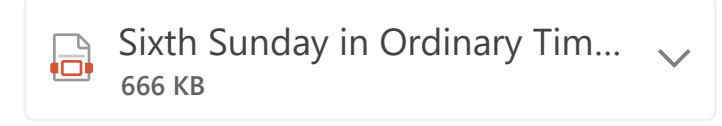
Holy Rosary: Monday-Saturday around 9.30am (earlier when a funeral is taking place)
